### **Increased Airflow and Insect Protection**

The fiberglass construction of the screen implements a system of yarns that are smaller in diameter, improving the overall openness by 5 percent over standard screen counterparts. These smaller yarns and extra openness block less of the homeowner's vision and allow increased light transmittance, even further enhancing the exterior view. It also improves airflow, allowing fresh breezes to flow through freely.

While the smaller yarn diameter increases openness by blocking less airflow and light, the holes in between the yarns are actually 30 percent smaller than standard fiberglass insect screens, resulting in exceptional protection against very small insects.
