

HOW TO MEASURE DAYLIGHT OPENING (WINDOW GLASS AREA)

Materials Required

Tape measure

Safety glasses and gloves

The daylight opening is the visible glass area that does not include the frame. The daylight opening can be measured from the inside or outside of the home. Milgard Customer Service Representatives will need these measurements when you order replacement glass.



1. Glass is measured with the width measurement first and the height measurement second. Place the tape measure at one end of the glass and extend to the other end of the glass. Look carefully at the tape measure and include the glass measurement accurate to an 1/8th of an inch.



2. Repeat to determine height.

Safety Precautions

This activity is appropriate for individuals with an understanding of how to use simple hand tools. Remember to wear eye protection and to make sure that pets and small children are not present when performing these activities.
